

Established in 2013 as an independent research, development and extension-based organisation, Tablelands Farming Systems is a progressive, innovative, farmer-led group. Our aim is to help farm businesses be more profitable and resilient in the face of shrinking support for traditional research and extension services and increasing volatility.

Collectively TFS members farm over 60,000 hectares of the Southern Tablelands, run nearly 250,000 sheep and over 10,000 head of cattle. TFS members extend across a wide variety of enterprise types including wool, beef, meat sheep and cropping. Our members own and/or lease their farmland or run enterprises on behalf of other individuals or organisations. TFS:

Our current activities include the Soil Moisture Probe Network that underpins our seasonal outlook updates. Various, ongoing pasture research projects. We deliver regular training, workshops and field days.
